Additionally, there are compositions by Barnard students, including alumna author and geographer, Jeannette Mirsky. Of note is a seven inch vinyl record of the song "Barnard! Barnard!" which was recorded at the Waldorf-Astoria in 1964. The words and music to this song were composed by Richard Rodgers. There is also a songbook of the "Barnard! Barnard!" score.
